One boy and one girl will be selected without regard to race, color, national origin or ancestry, age, religion, or disability.

Application Requirements: In order to be considered for the Shepherd Lions Club Scholarship, applicants must submit all of the following:

1. A completed Shepherd Lions Club Scholarship Application form.
2. A 200-word essay titled, “Community Service and its Importance in Today’s Society.” Essays must be typed and double-spaced.
3. A list of community and extra-curricular activities in which you participated over the past four years. Please provide the name of a contact person and a phone number for each listed activity.
4. A list of special awards and/or achievements you received. Please include pertinent information such as name of the award, reason for award, year received, etc.
5. High school transcript.

Award recipients and their parents/guardians will be invited to a Shepherd Lions Club dinner to meet Club members and receive your award.
