Dear GI-TEC- Mt. Pleasant Campus Families,

We hope this letter finds you healthy as we work together to curb the spread of COVID-19. If there is ever a time when the school district and families need to work together to educate our children, now is that time. We are about to embark on a plan for learning while at home, that will require cooperation, patience, and perseverance from both families and educators. Together, we can make this a meaningful learning experience for our students.

Our Mt. Pleasant Public School district submitted our "Continuity of Learning Plan" to the Gratiot Isabella RESD on April 10, 2020. This letter includes some of the key components of our plan and how we will work to best support your child during this time away from the school building. Our CTE teachers have been working hard in the past weeks to connect with every student in their classes in an effort to move forward in the best manner of distance learning that works with your household. Classes will start via distance learning on Monday, April 20th.

While nothing can replace the face-to-face interactions or our hands on approach to learning, our Career and Technical Education staff is committed to supporting your student's education during this time. We know that families are receiving a lot of information these days and we are going to work to control our communication to minimize the number of communications that you receive, while still providing the information you need.

Recommended Student Engagement in Learning Minutes

Our teachers will use this as a guide to organize learning at home lessons:

Instruction

As much as possible, teachers will provide learning opportunities that allow the student to complete their work at any time or day, during the scheduled week. Some teachers may have an OPTIONAL time for when their class of students may connect and "see" each other, using Zoom or Google Meet. Grade level or course packets are being created for students and families who prefer that mode of learning.

Student Expectations

It is expected that students will complete work that is shared by their teacher each week. Teachers will provide feedback to submitted work either electronically or over the phone, as much as possible. For students who have regular access to the internet, work may be submitted in the manner it is assigned virtually. For students who are receiving printed resources, one way to submit work to teachers for feedback might be to take a picture of the completed work and send it to your child's teacher. We would like to minimize the need to send materials back to the school, however, collection boxes/bins will be established at each building.

Parent Expectations

Parents are encouraged to help their child create a daily routine that includes time for their child to engage in the academic resources provided. It is encouraged that children have a dedicated workspace

in which they will do their school work at home. It is especially important that parents let their child's teacher know if they need printed materials or other supplies.

Communication from Teachers

Each teacher will send 1 weekly email to the student for their class. You and/or your student likely have been in communication with teachers since the beginning of the closure. As we continue with learning from home, families/students should expect to receive a weekly communication from their child's teacher(s).

Staff Office Hours

Our certified staff will host "office hours." This is an opportunity for students and parents to connect and receive support quickly, either by phone or by email. Staff can always be contacted through email, and typically responding within 24 hours, Monday through Friday, is the basic expectation.
